## **Old Business**

- Vandalism at park and diamonds-
  - Pavilion- light bulbs broken out.

  - Approved to pay \$10,039.27
  - Claim \$5,397.07—keep an eye to make sure this claim amount returns to Parks budget

## **New Business**

- Mulch on trails
  - o Idea to pull from compost
  - Pricing cost of mulch- ask Katie (KS suggested Bueschings)
    - Large mulch company near New Haven
    - Hulen's? Jeff Straessle- Samara Landscaping
- JPR Proposal- discussed contract for planning of new park space; Board approved payment of \$9,800 to begin process
  - Professional plans are necessary to seek cost estimates; cost estimates are necessary to seek grant funding

- Community Center repairs
  - Painting, cleaning, chair rack repair/purchase new- Ann checking with Victor Rivera of New Horizons Painting to confirm interior paint color; another option to is do color matching via Home Depot (will need to take a chunk of paint for them to match from)
  - o Discussed need to have center deep cleaned.
  - Approved purchase of new chair rack; discussed the need to add explicit directions of how to load the rack to avoid future damage from overloading the top of the rack
  - No smoking/ no vaping signage- Ann to send Rita a purchase request for adhesive sheet protectors for printed signage
  - Soap dispensers- Clark Wakemen- ask for assistance
- Park Bathrooms- discussed potential upgrades to bathrooms to include an all-in-one sink, soap dispenser, hand dryer (as seen at Augusta Hills Community Center); an attractive option as it would remove the paper towels from the bathrooms which are used to clog toilets (to vandalize the bathrooms)
  - Determined that this option is likely cost prohibitive unless upgrades to the bathrooms could be included in larger LWCF grant plans when developing new land
  - Discussed need to replace soap dispensers inside the Community Center and deep cleaning of all park bathrooms
  - How to prevent damage- increased police patrols happening
- Summer Bash at Eley Park- July 1, 2023 (9am to 1pm)
  - o Partnering with NCPL (slip & slide) & AFD to open hydrant
  - Schedule discussion with Katie, Ruth, Chad—protocols with food safe handling
    - Ann to reach out
- Tree removal/ground repair- Lisa working with Brian Carroll to remove remaining down tree behind the Community Center
- Allen County fencing- Lisa reaching out to secure specific date of repair work
- Freedom Festival donation ideas
  - Sponsor talent show

  - Discussed putting in the farther concession stand
  - Need to order a temperature-controlled box to store unit
  - Idea to install a unit case in the open which has a tamper alarm and red flashing light to find
